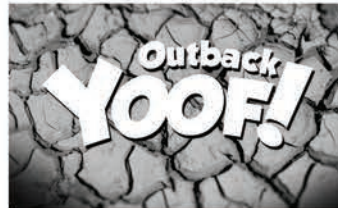

The children and young people, affectionately called 'Yoof' are an important part of our church family. They stay with us for the first part of the service then activities are provided 'outback' including bible stories, crafts and music...

PASTOR'S NOTES

It is interesting as we read about the outworking of joy in the Bible it often overflows into generosity. We are reading Chronicles in our 'Bible In a Year' at the moment, and as David celebrates all that God has done for His people, it is his vision to have a temple built for the LORD, carried out by his son Solomon. David not only sources all that is needed for its construction - he pours in his own personal wealth, and asks if others will do the same. It says that they 'gave willingly'. In the same way the members of the

early church saw nothing 'as their own, but had everything in common'.

2 Corinthians 9: 6-7 reminds us that God loves a cheerful giver. It is just a natural overflow that when the shadow of sin is removed through rejoicing because we recognise all that has been done for us and count our blessings, we want to pour that out to others too, and give it back to God, whether that means generosity with our time, our skills, our finances or resources.
