1. “The Lord will fight for you; you need only to be still.” (Exodus 14:14)
2. “Now then, stand still and see the great things the Lord is about to do before your eyes.” (1 Samuel 12:16)
3. “The Lord stood by me and strengthened me, so that through me the message might be fully proclaimed.” (2 Timothy 4:17)
4. “For God causes all things to work together for good.” (Romans 8:28)
5. “I have made you, and I will carry you; I will sustain you and rescue you.” (Isaiah 45:2)
